summer camp, as now this is done attention can shift to this event.

- Permission sought from Public Open Space Officer Cornwall Council prior to event notification form being sent. Deadline for submitting this is looming fast.
- Scouts Public Liability covers Fireworks and Bonfires.
- Fire safety being double checked with Andy Jones (Watch Manager, Fire Safety Inspection Officer, Cornwall Fire and Rescue Service).
- Lions are on-board with support for the night, crowd control etc.
- Support from Town Council Operations team may be needed, this will be requested officially after the next scouts planning meeting.
- Phil Griffiths and Gareth Foster will complete risk assessment and event notification form.
- ➤ A team of volunteers/ scout leaders and explorer scouts will be asked to provide security once the bonfire is built, to prevent arson. A request for parent support was made at the AGM this month.
- Food hygiene certificates are being updated for the catering on the night. If anyone can loan a gas BBQ for the evening, this would be appreciated.

Donations already expected: Markets team; £500, Cinema team; £500, TTP £300, plus donations from JT. JT has booked Celebration Pyrotechnics and has paid the deposit payment. JT asked for all the donations to be passed to him and then he will arrange final payment of the fireworks invoice in advance. KB will message JH to give her an update following this meeting.
