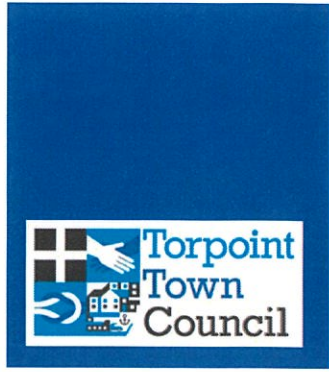

Accessibility Video

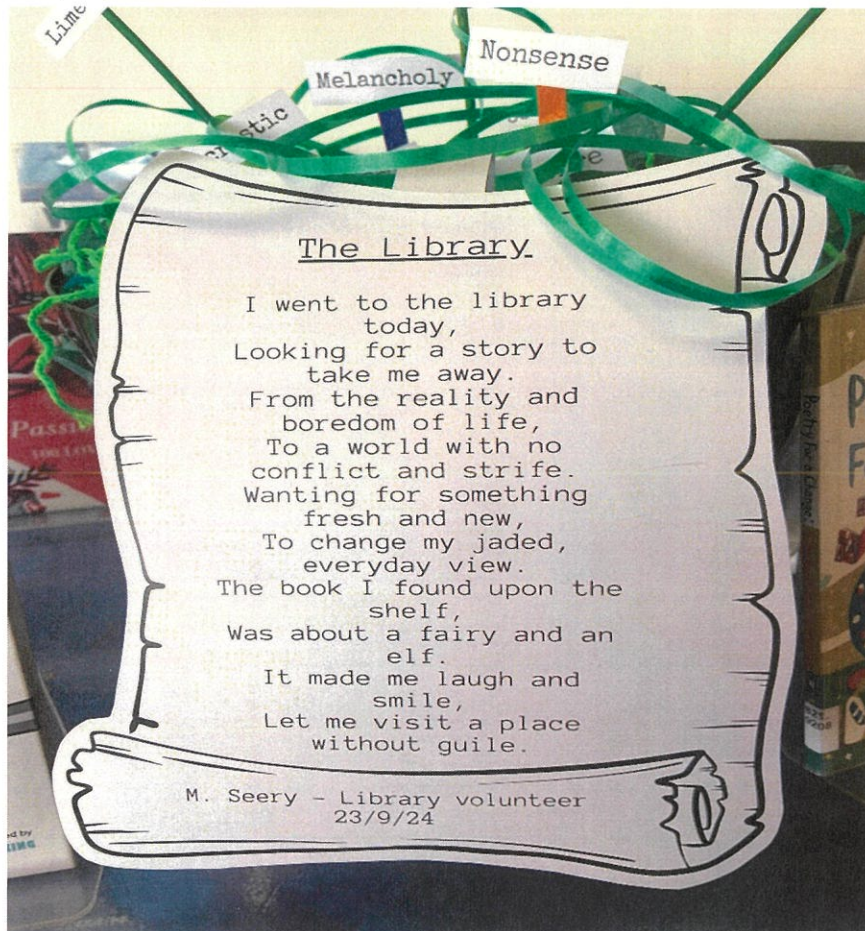
