	> The Mayor will be asked to judge the 'Best dressed Guy competition', also
	light the bonfire, accompanied by a child/young person.
	> 6.30pm, light the bonfire;
	7.00pm – 7.15pm fireworks display;

- In advance of the event, the site will be marked out, with the turf safely removed, ready to be replaced after the event. There will be overnight security, the night before.
- ➤ The events risk assessment and event notification forms have been submitted, all local emergency services advised and three days before the event, a reminder will be sent.
- Food and drink will be sold, with Cub leaders assisting.
- First Aid assistance may be required from Torpoint and Rame Peninsula Lions.
- Additional lighting will be provided, using a generator.
- Phil Griffiths will email the council to request to borrow radios, ear pieces and hi viz. Also will request the council to provide support from Operations team during the evening, setting up boundaries, marshalling in advance of the fireworks being set up and then whilst the fireworks are taking place. Also, to circulate the poster and add to bus shelters.
- After the event has finished the site will be litter picked as well as the day after, with all rubbish removed from site.

## Christmas Lights switch on event and Christmas Tree 2024

- ➤ Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November Christmas light switch on.
- Council and volunteers will put up the Christmas lights and Christmas tree two weeks before.
- Christmas tree selection to be undertaken by the Mayor. JH explained the Cinema will donate funds towards the cost for the Christmas tree this year.
- KM happy to head up the entertainment for the event.
- Andy Martin and Jeremy Lock will both be available to support the production/stage etc.
- JM will look after the stallholders.
- Best dressed window competition. Agreed posters to be produced and distributed, KB offered to undertake. There will be no public voting this year. Mayor, Town Crier and Citizen of the year, will be asked to undertake a tour of the windows on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November, from 5.00pm.
- > Christmas Lights to be turned on by the Citizen of the Year.
- Torpoint & Rame Peninsula Lions will host Father Christmas in Bob's Barn and will look to run another date in December.

Mt Edgcumbe Christmas Fayre will be held on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> December and will be a ticketed event this year.
