	The consultant gave a brief summary:	
	Torpoint Project 4 – New Build of Community Hub & Residential	

- Consultation commenced 27th November 2024
- Masterplan public consultation completed at the Library and community hub on 9th and 12th December.
- Consultation ended Friday 10th January 2025.
- Consultation report issued 13th January 2025 for this meeting (more details to follow).
- > CIL bid being completed in preparation for submission.
- Awaiting outcome of ask for funding for RIBA 3 funding (more details to follow).
- ➤ Meeting held with Emily Kent at Cornwall Council 14th January 2025.
- Agreement for shortfall funding to start work on the Library (surveys etc. for demolition preparation).
- > Issue complaint from a resident, regarding loss of site line. Two residents' were invited to attend the Masterplan consultations, one of the residents' has attended. Second resident did not attend.

Masterplan Consultation

- ➤ Masterplan consultation report issued 13th January 2025 for this meeting.
- ➤ In general consultees 312+ are content with the Masterplan
- > 26 consultees gave feedback.
- Overlap of comments and numbers from the public to the online consultation.
- > Significant input from consultees with Arts and Cultural interest who visited the second public consultation event.
- Main issues appear to be:
 - o Car Parking too much, wrong place or too little need more
 - Car Park to the East will be unsightly to those in the town square
 - Insufficient arts and cultural space in the design and the need for the development to prioritise their need.
 - o Pavilion consideration for something else
 - A Bridge for crossing over lanes
 - Opportunity to landscape and create a view out to the Tamar
- Other issues surrounding art, culture transportation, loss of view to Abercrombie House.

Members' were given the opportunity to make comments on the Masterplan consultation report, with members' agreeing the themes and issues as detailed. Following consideration it is therefore **recommended** the report of the Masterplan consultation as previously circulated, is adopted by the town council, with no changes required.



Discussion with Emily Kent (Cornwall Council)

➤ Emily Kent is Head of Inclusion Skills and Growth at Cornwall Council

- Cllr Gardner had asked the consultant to meet with Emily Kent with respect to potentially accessing funding for the RIBA 3 Report, via Shared Prosperity Fund
- Closure date for next round of funding is 27th January 2025 at 1700.
- ➤ Minimum Bid Value is £200,000.

The consultant detailed the opportunities, which a funding bid of £200,000 could enable. This includes RIBA Stage 4, which is the technical design stage, [when the project's vision becomes a physical reality, and the final details of the design are refined]. Also, there is an opportunity to consider funding for a Feasibility Study for a Town Square.



Following consideration, it is therefore **recommended** to direct the consultant, with support from the Clerk, to progress a funding bid, to the Cornwall and Isles of Scilly Good Growth Fund, for a minimum bid of £200,000 to progress the lower Fore Street redevelopment, in partnership with Cornwall Council [as landowner] by the deadline of 1700 on 27th January 2025.

	be required with Cornwall Council then arranging the Referendum on the NDP.
