Proposal – Torpoint Neighbourhood Development Plan

Details – Following comments made at the initial Regulation 16 consultation, Torpoint Town Council, supported by Cornwall Council have chosen to make some amendments to the Torpoint Neighbourhood Development Plan, largely to reflect concerns raised by interested parties relating to the Northern Fringe development.

Consultation on the amended submission (Regulation 16) version of the Neighbourhood Development Plan is taking place from **Wednesday 29 January 2025 – Wednesday 12 March 2025 midnight**. All representations received from this consultation will be made available to an independent examiner, appointed to examine the Torpoint Neighbourhood Development Plan.
