I write to let you know that the Strategic Director Sustainable Growth and Development has taken an Individual Decision in relation to Adult Education Closures: <u>Issue details - Individual Decision - Adult Education Closures - Cornwall Council</u>

The decision is as follows: Camelford, Torpoint, Saltash, St Austell and Penzance are confirmed as closing no sooner than the 28.2.25, together with previously closed Callington. A change from the previous decision is that a centre in Launceston will remain open. The rationale for this is that other Further Education providers have a current or planned offer for the areas of Penzance, St Austell, Saltash and Torpoint, whereas there is no equivalent accessible offer in and around Launceston or large college presence.

Information Provided

The purpose of this report is to provide members with information supplementary to the individual decision on Adult Education centre closures.

This information is intended to assist members with any queries from residents who may be existing or potential future learners of Adult Education. It includes guidance from three Further Education colleges – the Cornwall College Group, Truro and Penwith College and City College Plymouth – regarding the available curriculum and how learners might access it.
