# **Review Saturday opening hours**

Currently the facility opens on the second Saturday every month, from 10am - midday. During the winter months, November-March, footfall ranges from 20-50 people. In the spring and summer months, numbers increase.

There are groups of people whose needs cannot be met during the normal opening hours of the library. Young people for example, so the ability to meet any needs for young people either with a coding group or stop motion film group, reducing the ability to engage with them. Along with families who have children with social anxiety or sensory or emotional challenges, that need a quieter environment. Consider a discussion whether the facility should open more frequently on Saturdays as a trial, to see if the facility can meet the needs of a wider demographics.

# Upgrading the café till.

It is an outdated system for the number of transactions required and is overly complicated for volunteers. Currently volunteers and staff are trained to use an older manual till in the café. It involves having each item coded up on a sheet and a long process to ring each item up. For one transaction on the till for one item, it requires six actions. Along with a separate phone with Sumup for card payments, this requires another three actions.

Café volunteers are trained well before using the till and card machine, however currently there is room for error. There are actions which cannot always be taken off the till roll, it has to be made up or corrected in other ways, the card machine can also be temperamental.

It is proposed to consider purchasing a new Sumup digital till. This would allow the process with cash and card to be simplified, as they are all in one place. It will be easy and more transparent to see and to correct any errors. It is a touchscreen tablet with pictures on for items purchased, it will generate reports on sales, look at profit margins, and it will allow us to have tighter control on stock and ordering.
